## Community Accountancy

Free support is provided to members through Voluntary Action Rotherham's (VAR) Community Accountancy Service. This includes free individual training and advice from the community accountant Heera Singh. We also make a financial contribution for groups to have their accounts examined through VAR. A bonus grant is available for well-kept accounts!

## Photocopying

Free black and white photocopying is available for members. Colour photocopying will incur a small fee.

## Insurance

RotherFed will pay for **public liability insurance** through a group policy provided by Zurich. Members are responsible for registering their group to opt in to this service.



## Stationery Packs

Available both to new and prospective members, stationery packs can help you get your group up and running, with various items from papers and envelopes, your new secretary will need to do their job effectively

## Legal Advice

We can now offer free initial legal support to community groups and tenants and residents associations who become or are members of the Federation . This will involve an initial one hour session provided by our solicitor Alan Robinson of Cross Keys Law. Help received could include support with constitutions, how to become a charity or company or detailed information on employment law.

## Safeguarding

Payment for free criminal record bureau checks for your volunteers are available through Rother Fed. To enable this service, you need to nominate a member of your group as the Protection Officer.
